What should you bring?

This list has been adapted from University of Illinois Housing. After receiving your room assignment, you will want to contact your roommate and discuss what each of you plan to bring. Decide who will bring large items such as the TV, refrigerator, etc. Will one of you bring a small refrigerator? How about decorating your room?

Note: Some homeowner's insurance policies do not cover residence hall belongings. Check your policy or consider purchasing renter's insurance for coverage.

For international students, please pack light, most items can be purchased on-line.

What's included in your room?

Armory House provides the following items to all residents: Desk chair, one trash can per student, white shower curtain with rod and rings, plunger, and toilet paper.

AH Main Residents: an XL Twin Size bed, mattress pad, desk with bookcase storage and file drawer, and small 3 drawer chest.

AH Suites Residents: a Full Size bed, mattress pad, closet organizer, desk with file drawer for hanging files, and an alcove area with small sink and shelving area

- Basic cold medicine & pain killers

Electronics and School Supplies

- Notebooks, folders & binders
- Pens, pencils, & highlighters
- Planner
- Backpack
- Computer, Power Cord, Laptop Locking Cable
- TV, Gaming System, Bluetooth Speaker

- Power Strip with Surge Protector (with 5-amp resettable circuit breaker; must be UL-approved with a heavy cord and three-prong grounding)

- Small Microwave, 800 watts or less (one per room)

- Dish Soap and Sponges
- Sealable Storage Containers

ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

The following items are NOT permitted in the residence halls:

- Wireless Internet Hub
- Halogen Lamps or Halogen Bulbs
- Hot Plate, Electric Skillet, Toaster, Toaster Oven, George Foreman Grill (or similar cooking or high-wattage appliances with exposed surfaces), Air Fryer
- Electric or Space Heater
- Candles, Kerosene Heater, Incense, Scent Pot Burners (or other fire hazards)
- Weapons: Air Pellet, Soft Pellet, Water, Paintball or BB Guns; Swords; Knives; etc.
- Alcohol (even empty, decorative bottles)
- Oversize Stereo Speakers
- Your Own Bed Mattress
- Hoverboards
- Extension Cords
- Large pieces of furniture
